way, you might recognize the music I used in the video if you've listened to my new album)

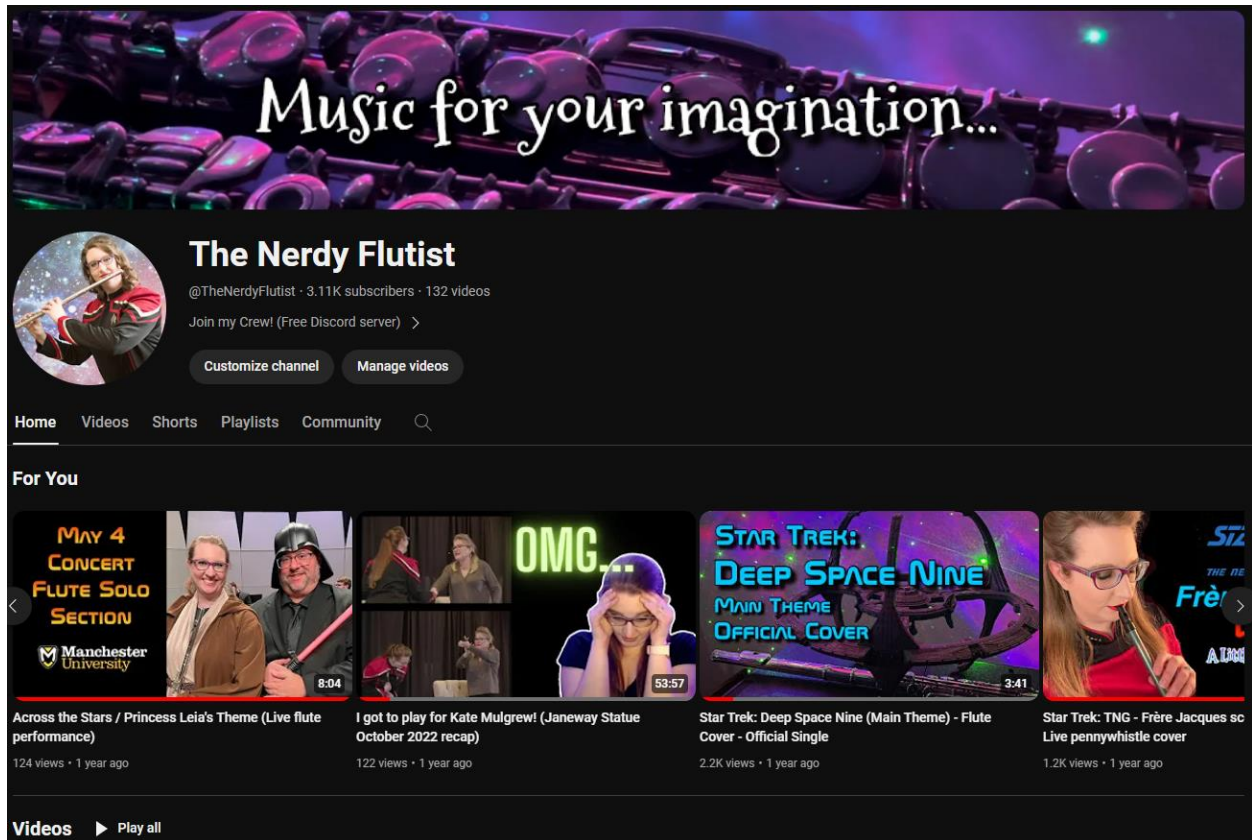

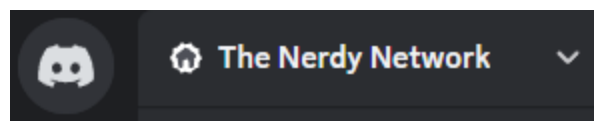
Become an Officer for even more updates...
